- at larger gatherings between January and May when Bishop Tom Wright will speak on Luke's Gospel (after Easter Bishop Tom will talk on the Acts of the Apostles)

### **Would you consider attending training so as to facilitate a Big Read group?**

The training takes place in *one* full evening. It is for people who

- have a little experience already in helping groups learn together
- will be accepting of different approaches to scriptural authority within their group
- wish their group to enjoy learning together
- will aim to help their group make profound links between St Luke's Gospel and their own experience

Each evening begins promptly at 7pm and finishes at 9pm. The session will be tightly packed, so please come early ready to start on time.
